



2018 Policy Priorities

Face It partners know both policy and practice solutions are necessary to end child abuse. Each year during the Kentucky General Assembly, Face It partners actively work on several policies that will prevent and end abuse. The 2018 priorities keep kids safe through adequate funding for children and families who have experienced — or are at risk of experiencing — abuse or neglect, solutions to better serve families who come into contact with the child welfare system, and ensuring courts have more complete information about alleged child abuse.

- Keep kids safe from abuse and neglect with adequate funding and improvements in how we respond to and support families.
- Increase transparency by moving functions related to appeals and cases within the Office of the Ombudsman to outside of the Cabinet for Health and Family Services.
- Keep kids safer from abuse by allowing adults to whom a child has disclosed abuse to testify in court.
