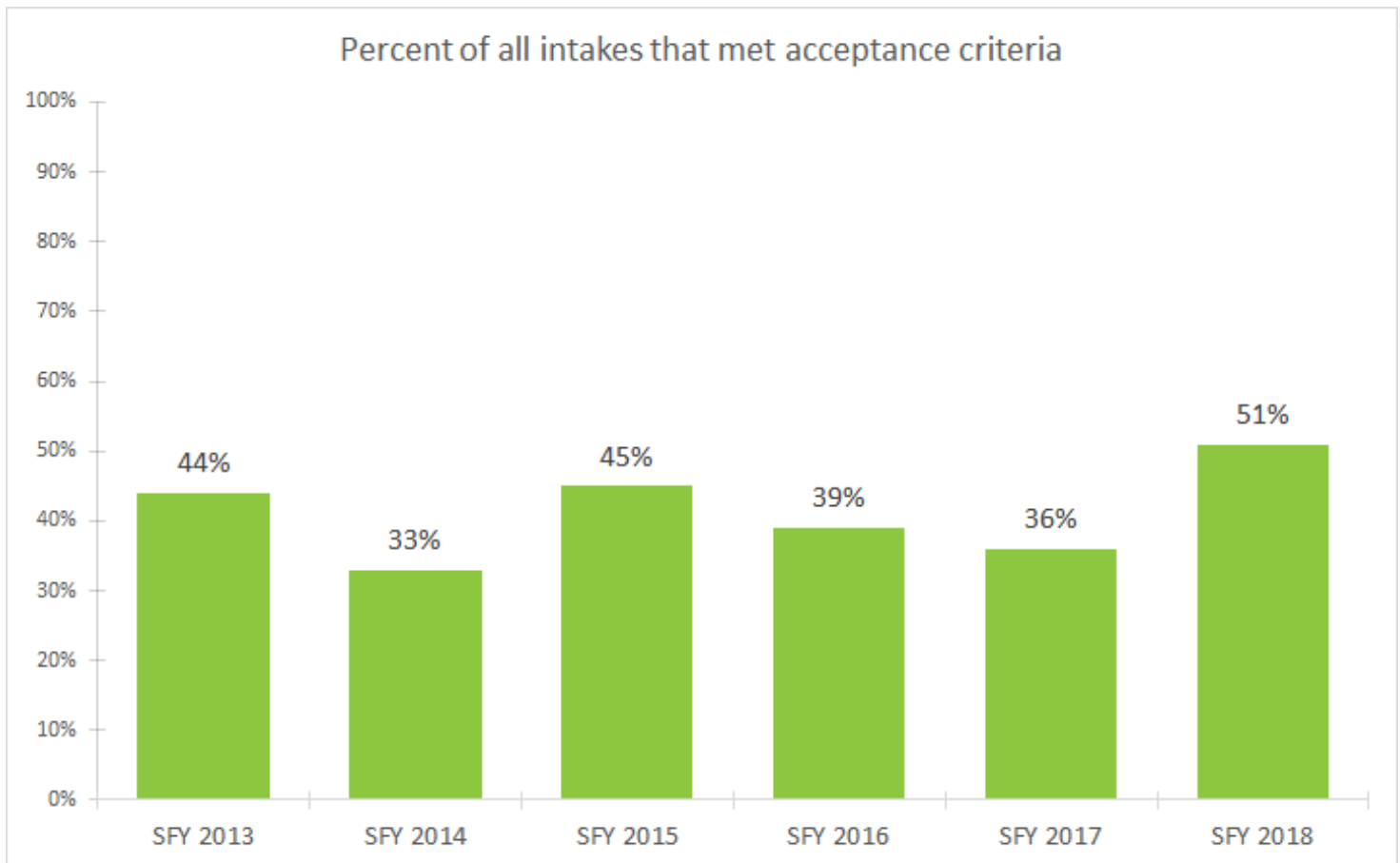


### 20,974 INTAKES RECEIVED FOR JEFFERSON COUNTY CPS IN SFY2018

We know that not all child maltreatment gets reported to authorities, and more children experienced abuse or neglect than numbers reflect. National research indicates far more children experience maltreatment by age 18 than annual rates convey.

#### DATA SOURCE & DETAILS

Source: Kentucky Cabinet for Health and Family Services, Department for Community Based Services. Data as of March 2019. Intakes reflect all community contacts with DCBS, including call and web referrals made by various community partners such as law enforcement, teachers, and health care providers. Intakes meeting acceptance criteria meet the statutory and regulatory definitions of what constitutes abuse, neglect, or dependency where the alleged perpetrator is in a caretaking role. However, meeting acceptance criteria is not a confirmation that child abuse or neglect actually occurred.
