Best Practices

• Trained over 13,000 youth in Speak Up, Be Safe child abuse prevention, conflict resolution, mediation, and cooperative games.

• Reached 875 adults through training on child abuse prevention, cyber safety, and trauma resilience.

• TEN-4 Trainings attracted more than 1,000 social workers, nurses, dentists, dental hygienists, EMTs, early childhood educators, and FRYSCs.

• In 2020, Face It's new partners serve a variety of youth and families in their communities, including youth in schools, youth with special needs, justiceinvolved youth, Latinx youth and families, and more.

Policy Wins for Kids

The Face It Policy Team works to identify and advocate for needed state policy changes to ensure kids are safe from abuse and neglect.

• An increase of \$31.5 million dollars in the DCBS budget to support evidence informed programs that keep families safely together while they recover from substance use disorder. Programs included KSTEP and START.

• \$1.5 million appropriated for domestic violence shelter, rape crisis centers, and child advocacy centers to assist with employer contribution rates for the Kentucky Employees Retirement System.

Community Outreach

• Created a COVID-19 resource page to give parents, caregivers, and professionals working with families a one-stop hub for COVID-related resources, such as managing the chaos at home, reducing stress, and having fun with family.

• Presented 60 gift bags to Neighborhood House, a community center that serves children and families.

Tegether We Can OOOOOOO • Developed "Virtually There," a new resource to assist teachers and other school staff in identifying signs of neglect or abuse in the virtual setting, establishing safety protocols, and tips to foster a more inclusive and emotionally welcoming classroom designed to meet the needs of the online learning environment.
