- Youth must be at least 16 years old and be able to participate in the group process, with parental or legal guardian permission.
- Providers or agency partners who understand and support the “Family and Youth-Driven System of Care” and want to assist KPFC in moving forward in this effort.

*This training is also a prerequisite for anyone who plans to complete the Kentucky Family Peer Support Specialist Core Competency Training (CCT) or the Kentucky Youth Peer Support Specialist Core Competency Training (CCT). **The KFLA must be successfully completed prior to approval of participation in either CCT offering.*
